Last year's Usk Show attracted over 22,000 visitors enjoying a welcome relaxation of the Covid 19 rules in the early autumn sunshine. This year the show will be held on Saturday 10 September at Gwernesney, near Usk (postcode for satnav NP15 1DD).

Usk Show is one of the best days out in South Wales. To support the show we would like to have as many exhibits as possible, particularly steam vehicles. Even if not working, please consider bringing engines to exhibit at the show as they are very popular with the public.

The John Haining trophy will be awarded to the best steam-powered model in the exhibition. Rosettes will be awarded to exhibits in the marquee and stationary engines.

Exhibitors must set up and be ready for the public by 9 am.

After unloading exhibits, parking adjacent to the marquee is strictly limited to blue badge holders and working steam support vehicles. All other vehicles must be parked in the field behind the marquee. The showground can then be accessed via the footbridge.

In the interests of safety, vehicles may not re-enter the showground until 5 pm.
